On September 1, the new year's Membership Dues invoices were transmitted to each club, Please make sure that Club Express has the current officers tied to your club. Invoices were sent via email to the President, Treasurer, and Membership Contact, and we want to make sure the correct people are getting the correct information. Depending on your Club's Membership year, this may be a great time to make sure your membership roster is updated. The only data required for the roster submitted for dues is the name of EACH member (this includes individuals in a family) and whether the member is a junior (age 17 and under) or Adult (18 and over). **Reminder: All dues payments should be mailed in sufficient time to arrive before November 1.**

Recently, there have been inquiries about why the dues set on the invoices are different than those in the Bylaws. Dues were last set by the Board during the April 2023 Board meeting by approving the budget. The dues at that time were set as \$1.50/adult and \$0.75/junior.

The CSC Bylaws in Article XII – Dues, Section 1. Annual Dues, Item B states: **The amount of per-Member dues shall be established by a two-thirds vote of the Board.** In absence of such determination, dues shall be as follows: 1. \$1.00 for each Member aged eighteen (18) or older. 2. \$0.50 for each Member under age eighteen (18). ExComm will be reviewing the Bylaws and proposing updating the dues section to reduce misunderstandings.

TRIPS (Lisa Beregi)

STEAMBOAT 2024 - Currently 194 signed up!

December 7-14 Online registration opened June 1st - all information is posted on the CSC website.

Transfer, lift and air will be in addition to package price. IKON pass good unlimited days, IKON Base needs 6th day = \$80, 6 day Adult ticket = \$456. Transfer from Hayden = \$120 RT, Denver - \$215. Lodging: Trappeurs Crossing 2, 3 and 4 bedroom condos are sold out. The Grand hotel or 2 bedroom condos as needed and with full occupancy requested.

All sign ups by August 1st will be in for a drawing to get lesson/lunch component free. This is a \$580 value and will be drawn at the Fall Conference.

Parking - one car per condo at Trappuers and tiered pricing at The Grand.

Package Price includes lodging, lessons, 3 lunches, 2 dinners and several apres: All condos at both properties \$1530, Grand hotel \$1630. Second payment of \$600 was due August 1st and final balance was due October 1st.

IKON PASS - Crescent Ski Council

Crescent Ski Council (or use your club link if have one) link. If you buy through these links, you get a deduct off your first trip with SAT. <u>Ikon Passes: Crescent Ski Council</u> Password is snow.

<u>BIG SKY January CSC Ski Week</u> - Currently 183 signed up and SOLD OUT! There is a growing waitlist right now.

January 18-25, 2025, all information is on the website. Since we have sold out and SAT is constantly trying to add more rooms unsuccessfully, we will offer off site lodging to anyone on the list or wanting to go that can find their own lodging. Price for offsite lodging (CSC activities and transfers) is \$420. Transfers - from Bozeman included with registration stating what time you must arrive by and depart by to utilize or will be on individual shuttles and prices. Lift Options –

OPTION 1 - Ikon Pass Products - all products require reservations thru online Ikon account. Ikon Passes offer no Tram Access.

*A **Full Ikon** pass is currently \$1269 when purchased from Sports America's link with the password snow. Buying this pass qualifies you for a \$50 trip discount, and there are NO blackout dates. *An **Ikon Base** pass offers 5 days at Big Sky. Sunday Jan 19th is blacked out. Currently \$919 from the Sports America site. You qualify for a \$30 trip discount & can purchase a 1 day ticket for Sunday if you want to ski all 6 days.

*An Ikon Session pass - offers 2, 3, or 4 day options but must be purchased directly at <u>ikon.com</u>. Black out on Sunday Jan 19th. Currently a 3 day is \$399, a 4 day is \$479.

OPTION 2 - Sports America Ikon Purchase - Site:<u>http://www.sportsamerica.com/ikon-crescent</u> Prices increased on Sept 1st.

OPTION 3 - Big Sky Freestyle Pass - go to Big Sky Passes are still available until sold out. Adult 4 day is \$450. 3-5 day pricing available, Sunday Jan 19th is a blackout so would need 1 day lift from registration page.

ALASKA 2025 Adventure Trip – May 13-25, 2025.

A presentation of the trip was given by Collette June 5 and is on the website. Online registration opened June 1st. Here is the electronic link to information on the trip as well as will be the registration site: Alaska Discovery Land & Cruise

We currently have 29 participants of the 40 double per room spots booked.

All CSC gateway cities are included in the price and will be an option on the registration. They are good until November 14th.

Due to flights into Fairbanks arriving very late at night, the package starts May 13th, and the extra night hotel is in the pricing.

Pricing may appear high, but it does include 6 nights land and 7 day Holland America cruise with 27 meals, cancel for any reason insurance (\$599), cruise port fees (\$684) and air with taxes and fees. Remember you are flying into Fairbanks and out of Vancouver. CSC is also planning that land tips will be covered.

We have 40 spots, so early registration is suggested to get desired cabin type and best air schedules. Price: Inside cabin \$6146, Window \$6746, and balcony \$7346. Collette travelers in last year get 5% off. Price goes up \$250 Nov 14th.

A Vancouver post night hotel is offered on the registration for those desiring not to rush off the boat and onto a plane.
